



Apollo Bay Golf Club: “How to apply for a handicap”

Step 1: Confirm that you are financially up to date with Apollo Bay Golf Club for the year in question (contact membership@apollobaygolfclub.org.au). Note, non-financial members may have their membership and handicap cancelled - following appropriate warnings. Non-financial members will not be able to progress to Step 2 and beyond.

Step 2: Complete either 3 x 18 holes or 6 x 9 holes of golf **under competition conditions**; and have your card marked by someone who has a Golf Australia Handicap (and current GolfConnect Number). Note, that "under competition conditions" does not necessarily mean in a competition, but rather that all the rules of golf are followed - as if you were playing in a competition. Hand your cards into the clubhouse, for the attention of the relevant handicapper.

Step 3: Provide your name, address, DoB and mobile phone number to the relevant handicapper.

Step 4: Send the information from Steps 2 and 3 above to the relevant handicapper:

Step 5: The relevant Handicapper will send confirmation of your handicap to your email address; or alternatively call your mobile phone to address any questions that may arise. You will be registered in GolfConnect as having a home club at Apollo Bay Golf Club.

Step 6 (Optional): Download the MiScore App to your mobile phone, together with OneGolf App. A username and Password will be allocated to you by the Handicapper. Note, the MiScore App will cost an annual fee to enable electronic scoring in competitions at Apollo Bay Golf Club and around Australia. Apollo Bay Golf Club also has an obligation to pay an additional Club Fee to MiScore and Golf Australia for your registration. OneGolf is the go-to source to enter Club Competitions, and Prize accrual.
